Convocation Participants

Jinyue Li is graduating with a master of arts in second language teaching. Born and raised in a small inland city in northwest China, she is the only child in her family. Through a dual-degree program between Beijing Normal University and Brigham Young University, she came to the United States to continue her academic journey. During her time at BYU, Li has served as a research assistant in the Department of Linguistics and as a teaching assistant in the Department of Asian and Near Eastern Languages. At multiple academic conferences, she has presented her research exploring how neuroimaging technology can deepen understanding of Chinese character acquisition and second language learning. She is currently completing her student teaching at a Chinese immersion elementary school while working toward Utah teacher licensure. In the future, Li hopes to pursue a doctoral degree and continue contributing to the field of language education.

Kathryn Douglas is graduating with a bachelor of arts in Korean and a minor in Asian studies. Born in Tucson, Arizona, and raised in Twentynine Palms, California, she is the fourth of five children. During her time at BYU, she worked three years for the Korean program as the student program coordinator for the internship program with Kyung Hee University. Additionally, she worked as a teaching assistant for Korean 102, 201, and 202. Douglas participated in an international study abroad program in South Korea and was there during its martial law declaration in December 2024, which led her to choose the topic of Korea's martial law history for her senior capstone research. In her spare time, Douglas enjoys dancing and choreographing for a hip-hop team called Hot Pot based out of Provo. She is excited to continue pursuing Korean studies as a graduate student in South Korea this fall.

Kasia McPherson is graduating with a bachelor of arts in interdisciplinary humanities and a minor in French. She is the daughter of two BYU alumni, and both her older and younger sisters have also attended BYU, with three more siblings still at home. While at BYU, McPherson has been a part of the French Honor Society (Pi Delta Phi), and she has loved working as a teaching assistant for Western Humanities 2. From 2023 to 2024, she served in the Brazil Santa Maria Mission. She studied abroad in Paris in 2022 and interned at Jesuit Refugee Service in London in 2025. In addition to Portuguese and French, McPherson also studies Spanish and Mandarin. She started singing when she was eight. Some of her favorite roles have been Christine in *Phantom of the Opera*, Maria in *West Side Story*, and the Witch in *Into the Woods*. After graduation, she plans to pursue a law degree with a goal to work in immigration law.

Emma Dansie is graduating with a bachelor of arts in Italian and a minor in global business and literacy. Originally from Fort Worth, Texas, she has a deep connection to Italy that began during her teenage years in Milan and continued through her service in the Italy Milan Mission. While at BYU, Dansie served as a media services specialist for BYU Broadcasting and a script research assistant at the BYU Center for Family History and Genealogy. She recently went on a study abroad trip to Europe, where she visited businesses and cultural landmarks across the continent. Outside of school, Dansie enjoys cooking, singing, reading, and playing the piano.
